

SFMUG Short Movie Festival - May 1st, 2008

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

The Santa Fe Macintosh User Group is a non-profit organization dedicated to showcasing the Macintosh and its potential as a creative tool. Our goal is to create a forum where artists, musicians, painters, moviemakers, storytellers and everyone else can share their experiences and techniques.

The **SFMUG Short Movie Festival** is open to movies no longer than five minutes in any category.

All film entries must be submitted in Quicktime .mov format at 720x480 and delivered on CD, DVD or uploaded file to be considered for selection and received postmarked by the April 16th, or uploaded by April 21st, 2008. Check www.santafemug.org for uploading information.

Submission CDs and DVDs will not be returned unless requested with an enclosed Self-addressed stamped envelope or DVD box followed by an e-mail to zoom@redquyn.com

There is a non-refundable \$15.00 entry processing fee for films 5 minutes or less. Entries must be submitted with the processing fee. All entries must include press information with a synopsis(make sure logline/blurb is written on the entry form), cast/crew list and one production still that represents your film. Main still and additional stills can be included on delivery medium or uploaded in a compressed .PDF file. All photos provided must be clearly identified on the back, or in the file name. Photos will not be returned and may be used for festival promotions. Make sure your entry is postmarked by the entry due date.

Award Categories: Unless **SFMUG Short Movie Festival** is given instructions, all film entries will be considered for the Audience Award competition. All films go through a screening process to be accepted. No explicit adult content! All acceptance decisions are final. Winners agree to participate in the publicity for the **SFMUG Short Movie Festival** as well as other promotional events, including the web site. The audience's determination of the winners is final.

SFMUG will not accept any commercial, industrial entries.

Selected film entries will be notified by April 25th, 2008 via e-mail and listed in the accepted 2008 films on www.santafemug.org.

Non-English language produced films must have English subtitles or be dubbed in English.

All entrants certify that they have been given full rights to use any and all music in their films.

The title of the work and name of entrant must be on all CDs, DVDs, mailing containers, labels and all uploaded files.

Movie materials will be handled with utmost care, but neither **SFMUG Short Movie Festival** staff nor supporting Theater organizations can assume responsibility for damage or loss of the CDs, DVDs, or other movie materials, en route or otherwise, during the course of the festival's possession.

Accepted 2008 Films:

Filmmakers accepted and attending the festival are responsible for their travel, lodging, and all other expenses.

Filmmakers accepted into the **SFMUG Short Movie Festival** - will be entitled to the following:

One FREE admittance to the May 1st, 2008 SFMUG Short Movie Festival. General admittance for non-members is \$4.00. The free admittance can be used by the filmmaker, or if not attending, by their surrogate.

Prizes:

1st Place- Apple iPod Touch, **2nd Place** - Apple iPod Nano and **3rd Place** - \$50.00 Apple iTunes Gift Card. "Best of" SFMUG SMF08 movies will be shown at a future Film Industry Night in Albuquerque, NM

All prizes will be given at the event, or shipping, handling and insurance must be arranged. If winner is outside U.S.A., a pre-arranged surrogate U.S.A. resident must receive the prize and be noted on submission form. SFMUG will not be responsible for any customs or shipping.

First, Second and Third Place Audience Award winners will be chosen and announced the night of the **SFMUG Short Movie Festival**, then listed on www.santafemug.org thereafter.
